## FACULTY FELLOWS AND GRADUATE FELLOWS AT SAMSI

## **Responsibilities of Faculty Fellows**

- 1. Attend the opening and transition workshops for your program, and others that are relevant to your own research interests;
- 2. Play an active role in the set up and operation of the working groups normally we would expect each Faculty Fellow to act as chair or co-chair for a working group;
- 3. Assist with organizing and teaching the graduate course(s) associated with your program;
- 4. Be available (if needed and appropriate) to act as scientific mentor for one of the postdoc fellows appointed to your program;
- 5. Serve as mentor to a Graduate Fellow, if appropriate (very often you will have the opportunity to appoint one of your own graduate students as a Graduate Fellow, and we would expect you to help make sure that student understands his or her SAMSI responsibilities as well as continuing your regular role as PhD advisor).

## **Responsibilities of Graduate Fellows**

- 1. Attend the orientation session for your program;
- 2. Enroll in the graduate course(s) associated with your program (fall and spring if both are offered);
- 3. Register for and attend the opening workshop, and other relevant workshops during the program;
- 4. Participate fully in at least one working group;
- 5. Present, at the Graduate Student Day in April, the research that you have done during your program;
- 6. Serve as a mentor in at least one of the SAMSI Undergraduate Workshops;
- 7. Fill out all the required SAMSI reports (see http://www.samsi.info/forms-and-resources/graduate-students).
